MOVEMENT MENTOR PROGRAM



Jackson was born with spina bifida and hip dysplasia. He met William about 3 years ago at the Shriners Hospital where they were in a Spina Bifida Physical Therapy Program together. Jackson and William (pictured left) have the opportunity to dance together in the Movement Mentor Program. 'So far, the class has been a delight! It helps them be more aware of their abilities through movement and dance." Says Jackson's mom, Clarisa.

Movement Mentor is an adaptive dance program which pairs special needs dancers, age 5-22 with one of our BWA advanced students as a mentor in their weekly dance classes. Classes are taught by faculty member Jessica

Baynes at JEQBC. Each year our SLC Movement Mentor students like Jackson and William, alongside their Mentors, perform in the Primary School Spring Showcase in May. Similar classes are taught at our Utah County Campus.
