BALLET ICON


The ballet world recently lost a legend and true pioneer of ballet in Utah. Bené Arnold passed away last week. We want to take a moment to honor her.

Imagine that you are a young dancer auditioning for The Nutcracker at Ballet West and in walks a 70-something woman who does "a big cartwheel right into the splits!" – her signature move. Ballet West Artistic Director, Adam Sklute recalled this experience describing Bené as "passionate, joyous, very funny".

In 1964 Bené Arnold joined Ballet West as the company's first Ballet Mistress. She also taught on the faculty of the University of Utah Ballet Department. During her time at Ballet West, she was a children's Rehearsal Director to young dancers in The Nutcracker, as well as Director of what would eventually become the Ballet West Academy.

It is almost impossible to calculate the number of dancers that Bené Arnold has taught, from the smallest buffoon in The Nutcracker, to university students, and professional dancers. Her reach is far and her inspiring words never forgotten.
